WW1 Centenary Exhibition

A centenary exhibition on the later stages of World War One, 'the Armistice and the Peace' will take place in Warkworth War Memorial Hall, on Saturday, 25 August 2018 with the assistance of Warkworth Women's Institute. The exhibition will open from 10 am until 5pm. Admission will be free, with refreshments available, plus a raffle. All profit from the event will be for Warkworth branch Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal.

The exhibition will also include the history of Women's Suffrage to mark the centenary of votes for women aged 30 years and over in 1918. The British Legion wish to borrow any WW1 material for the exhibition held by family members from the Warkworth and Amble areas such as photographs, medals, newspaper cuttings, uniforms, prisoner of war items etc., especially items from Northumberland regiments.

Please come along to remember the bravery of those who fought, lived and died in the First World War. Our village War Memorial Hall, paid for by public subscription and dedicated after the war, is a lasting legacy to those who made the ultimate sacrifice.
